Application Instructions

To apply for Unity Lodge's Annual Scholarship, please complete the attached application form and submit it post marked by **March 30th**. Late applications will not be accepted.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1) Student must be a graduating high school senior in the current year.
- 2) Student must be a citizen of the United States of America and a legal resident of California residing in the County of San Diego for at least one year.
- 3) Student must have a minimum of an un-weighted 3.5 cumulative GPA.
- 4) Student must be accepted by an accredited 4-yr. institution of higher learning as a full-time undergraduate freshman in the Fall of the current year.
- 5) Student need not show evidence of financial need.

Submittal Requirements:

- 1) Completed Application and personal essay of 1,000 words or less.
- 2) Two (2) letters of recommendation, one from a teacher or school administrator, and one from an adult other than an educational professional who is familiar with the applicant, such as a pastor or scout troop leader.
- 3) Current official transcript.
- 4) College acceptance letter.
- 5) A copy of the College Board Entrance Examination (SAT) score.
- 6) Self Addressed envelope with postage for notification purposes.
